Year 5/6

This week, in Year 5/6, we have begun our new learning in Maths focusing on decimals. We have looked at the place value of decimal digits and have multiplied decimals by 10, 100 and 1,000. We have started to divide decimals by 10, 100 and 1,000 ready to apply our knowledge to reasoning and problem solving questions. In DT, we have used CAD to develop our initial ideas for our pulley systems, ready to begin prototyping next week. In science, we completed an experiment to observe what happens to a solute when dissolved in a solvent to produce a solution. We investigated how the temperature and volume of solvent might impact the rate the solute dissolves.
